

FAR EASTERN UNIVERSITY
**IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATION OF THE OMNIBUS
ELECTION CODE OF 2022**

To effectively execute the 2022 Omnibus Election Code, the University COMELEC by virtue of the powers of the en banc issues the following implementing rules and regulations:

ARTICLE 1. TITLE AND SCOPE.

1.1 The document shall be referred to as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations". The rules and regulations shall apply to all entities involved and engaged with the university elections.

ARTICLE 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING

2.1 Additional requirement for incumbent officers cited in Article 13.1.3 of the OEC concerning the attendance at least two (2) seminars or events organized by SDEV is waived for this election cycle.

2.2 Electronic signatures (e-signatures) of the candidates' parent and/or declared guardian's consent and signature is not allowed. Candidates whose parents or declared guardians are abroad or are not able to sign the document physically are allowed to submit a scanned copy of the document containing the same requirements as outlined in Article 13.1.7 of the OEC.

ARTICLE 3. CAMPAIGN, VOTING, CANVASSING, AND PROCLAMATION OF WINNERS

3.1 **Election Period.** Election period shall commence from the accreditation of political parties (April 2, 2022) until the proclamation of winners (May 6, 2022).

3.2 **Posters.** Each political party and independent candidates shall be allowed to produce any number of poster design and layout for their candidates.

3.2.1 Total number of copies of all posters, regardless of design and layout, should be equal to the following number of bulletin boards:

For political parties in the following positions:

- a. FEUCSO – total number of bulletin boards in FEU – twenty (20)
- b. Institute SCs – total number of bulletin boards under the Institutes - five - (5)
- c. Academic Organizations – two (2)

For independent candidates for the following positions:

- a. FEUCSO – total number of bulletin boards in FEU – five (5)
- b. Institute SCs – total number of bulletin boards under the Institutes – two (2)
- c. Academic Organizations – one (1)

3.3 Speeches in Room-to-Room Campaigns. Room-to-room campaigns are allowed in accordance with the following guidelines:

3.3.1 All candidates per party, and independent candidates, regardless of organization will hold room-to-room campaigns for strictly ten (10) minutes.

3.3.2 Only a maximum of two (2) candidates are allowed to campaign per classroom. Campaign managers are to wait outside of the classroom and will provide the Feedback Form for the Room-to-Room campaign issued by the COMELEC to the faculty who will evaluate the speeches.

3.3.3. Candidates are to adhere to the health standards of the University in their room-to-room campaigning and Article 20.2.4 of the OEC.

3.4 Submission of Candidates' Photos. Candidates will submit photos to the Student Development to be used for the election and will abide by the following requirements and dimensions.

3.4.1 The size of the photo must be 8"x10" (8 inches by 10 inches) 300 pixels per inch and in jpeg format

3.4.2 The photo must be in full color and should follow the University's standard for graduation photos

ARTICLE 4. SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE FOR VOTING.

4.1 Voting will be fully online and administered on the TAMS GO App.

4.2 Voting will begin on May 4 at 12:01 AM and end on May 6 at 3:00 PM. Students may vote any time and any where within the said dates and time.

4.3. SDev, ITS, and University COMELEC shall draft as separate guidelines and instructions for the conduct of the online elections.

ARTICLE 5. REVISIONS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

5.1 The COMELEC may revise the guidelines as it deems necessary for efficient implementation.

ARTICLE 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

6.1 If there any provisions which is deemed to be invalid, the other rules and regulations will not be affected and will remain in full force and effect


6.2. These implementing rules and regulations are being promulgated in consideration of the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic, and shall not be used as a precedent in the crafting of subsequent implementing rules and regulations, and amendments to the Omnibus Election Code of 2022.


ARTICLE 7. EFFECTIVITY.

7.1 The rules and regulations shall take effect immediately upon the approval of the majority of the members of the University Commission on Elections.
